The Reading Fiction Units Assess:

1. Your ability to identify and interpret information and ideas in a text.
2. Your ability to analyse and explain how writers use language and structure to create meaning and effect, and influence the reader.
3. Your ability to critically evaluate a text, and to share your opinion about it.

The Reading Non-Fiction Units Assess:

1. Your ability to identify and interpret information and ideas in multiple texts, and use those details as evidence to support your ideas.
2. Your ability to analyse and explain how writers use language to create meaning and effect, and influence the reader.
3. Your ability to look at and compare the attitudes and ideas of two different writers.

Both Writing Units Assess:

1. Your ability to communicate ideas in a clear, effective and creative way that is organised and structured, adapting your tone, style of writing and voice to suit purpose, form and audience.
2. Your ability to use a range of vocabulary, sentence styles, grammar and punctuation to present your ideas in a way that is accurate, impactful and clear.
