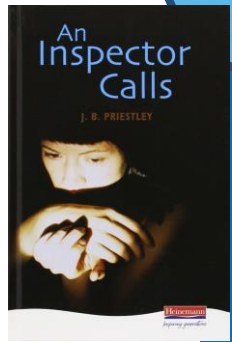

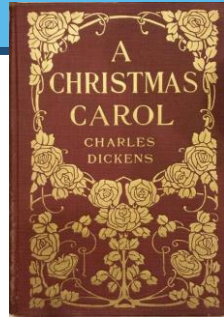
A mysterious police inspector questions a wealthy British family about the suicide of a young woman.
